TOURIGA NACIONAL 2018

Wine: It is a red varietal made exclusively from grapes **TOURIGA NACIONAL** with Controlled Origin Denomination (DOC Óbidos), at Lisbon wine region..

Vineyard: **TOURIGA NACIONAL** grapes were harvested at "Vinha dos Versos" vineyard, at **Quinta do Porto Nogueira**, a terroir at Lisbon Wine Region. Vineyard is conducted under sustainable practices and production is certified independently under "Normas de Produção Integrada" (Sustainable Production Standards". We privileged the non-mobilization of soils and the application of natural origin manure.

Vineyard area extent: 0,92 ha at "Vinha dos Versos".

Vineyard solar Orientation: Northwest-Southeast (NW-SE) at "Vinha dos Versos".

Soil Type: clay-limestone

Year of plantation: 2012

Harvest: Manually made by our workers to 18 kg boxes at optimum point of maturation.

Winemaking: Rigorous selection of bunches and berries made over 100% of **TOURIGA NACIONAL** grapes. Fermentation in mills, with previous maceration.

Finishing and Stage: 10 months stage in French Seguin Moreau oak barrels of 3rd year use. Bottling, labelling and finishing performed in our cellar.

Tasting Notes: Violet ruby wine with aromas of small forest fruits. Some discreet floral notes and slight vegetal revealing the Atlantic character. In the mouth it presents excellent balance and freshness, with acidity present but well integrated in the wine structure, intense and alive tannins but with maturity, finishes frank, balanced and fresh, with very good final persistence. Very pleasant.

Analysis: alcohol strength 13% vol.; total acidity - 5,07 g/dm³; PH 3,56 and residual sugar - 0,6 g/dm³
